While our hearts are truly expectant for this brand new year, we are, at the same time, truly grateful for every ministry that has taken place in 2009. For every child that was fed and comforted....for every soul reached out....for workers and leaders trained and equipped....for lives that have been touched. We are all in these, TOGETHER....

ON TRAINING...

In 2009, we had the privilege of *teaching* two batches of YWAM's Discipleship Training School (DTS) at the Antipolo Training Center. One was in March with 10 students and only one from overseas; and the other was just this December with 7 students, 2 of them are foreigners. DTS is actually 6 months of ground breaking work which seeks to lay a foundation in the lives of the believers. Chat and I taught "Authority of the Believer" as

part of their lecture phase, five days in a row for each batch.

Right here in Luzon, we currently oversee three CBI's (Calvary Bible Institute). We direct the one in Cainta, and provide oversight and ministry coordination for the two new schools opened up in 2009 – in Camarines Norte, Bicol (which started up in June) and in San Rafael, Bulacan (which commenced in August). We have a total of 205 students in all three schools. We are thrilled to see some graduates of our school take up the baton and teach in these new schools we have. Last March, we graduated 44 students from CBI Cainta and expecting over 30 to graduate in April 2010. Graduation for Bicol will be in May; and July for Bulacan.

For our schools in Asia, we've seen 18 run until the finish line for the CBI in Majhitar, Sikkim State, India in April; 21 in Thimpu City, Bhutan in August; and 22 in Khon Kaen, Thailand in September. What a great opportunity,

not only to teach these nationals; but also see their beaming faces on the day of their graduation.

ON OUTREACHES....

Four feeding programs were accomplished in 2009 reaching out to over 100 kids and 50 adults in each event. What a joy, not only being able to give physical food to the less fortunate; but even serve them spiritual food that will affect their eternity!

Two children's outreaches were held at McDonald's this December to give a Christmas treat to a total of 102 indigent kids. It was heart touching to watch most of the older children packing their food and saving it to bring to their parents and younger siblings.

253 oldies were reached out in February when we visited the Home for the Aged and just loved on the grandpa's and grandma's in the institution.

ON MISSIONS.....

Aside from the bible schools we visited in Asia, where we taught and help graduated our students, we also had the blessed opportunity of leading our most recent alumni into their overseas mission exposure trip in Thailand in April. We were 27 in all which composed our mission team and we ministered in nine (9) local churches and helped launched one in Khon Kaen. We likewise had a whole day trip in Laos, where the team did a significant prayer walk claiming the nation for Jesus!

I (Jim) was back in Thailand in July with our Regional Director, Craig Kuehn to visit our missionary team in Khon Kaen and Chang Mai and helped encourage their entire families.

In October, Chat and I spent five days in Hongkong to coordinate the upcoming mission trip of our current students in Hongkong and China on April 5-16,

ON PRAYER.....

Since October 2009, we begun significant prayer journeys with some of our leaders and workers, assembling in prayer at dawn (4:00 – 5:30 a.m.) to seek God's face and favor. Certainly, it was a sacrifice waking up long before the day; **BUT IT'S ALL WORTH IT.** We have finished 3 laps of journey receiving miracles and dramatic answers to prayer. This is one reason we're all the more excited for 2010. We know that more blessings are in stored in answer to our continued and persevering prayer. We do pray for YOU, our partners EVERY DAY and declare the Lord's abundant provisions for your life as we commence another 21-day journey in our Dawn Watch this January.
